#### SUMMARY:

Phase 2B of the Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Construction Project (Project) contains four (4) stations along the Glendora to Pomona alignment – Glendora, San Dimas, La Verne and Pomona – each of which will have an accompanying parking facility.

All four parking facilities are surface parking lots, adjacent to the station. Capacity ranges from approximately 240 spaces to 550 spaces. There are spaces dedicated to accessible parking and EV charging at each station, with room for additional charging stations in the future.

All parking lots have been designed with passenger pick-up and drop-off areas to accommodate rideshare vehicles and buses. Site enhancements include shelters, benches, bike racks and storage and trash receptacles. All parking lots have CCTV coverage, directional signage, perimeter fencing, lighting, sidewalks, enhanced crosswalks and landscaping.

This report is accompanied by a presentation on the parking facilities.

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
#### **FOOTHILL GOLD LINE PROJECT STATUS**

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#### FOOTHILL GOLD LINE PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Foothill Gold Line Construction Authority (also known as the Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Construction Authority) is an independent transportation agency created in 1998 by the California State Legislature to plan, design and build the Metro Gold Line light rail system from Union Station in Downtown Los Angeles to the Montclair TransCenter in San Bernardino County. The \$3 billion, 37-mile program is being built in three segments and when completed will connect the cities of Los Angeles, South Pasadena, Pasadena, Arcadia, Monrovia, Duarte, Irwindale, Azusa, Glendora, San Dimas, La Verne, Pomona, Claremont and Montclair to the expanding network of rail lines throughout Los Angeles and San Bernardino Counties.

The first segment of the line from Union Station to Pasadena was completed in 2003, and the second segment from Pasadena to Azusa was completed in 2015. The third segment, from Glendora to Montclair (Figure 1) broke ground in December 2017 and is being mostly funded by Los Angeles County Measure M with additional funds coming from: residual Measure R funds not used for the Pasadena to Azusa segment, State of California Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program funds (including SB1 funds), and funding from San Bernardino County. Four contracts are being used to build the 12.3-mile, six station segment which is anticipated to reach substantial completion by 2025 to Pomona. The anticipated schedule for the Pomona to Montclair segment will be determined once the necessary additional funding is secured.



# GLENDORA TO MONTCLAIR MANAGEMENT ISSUES

#### ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR POMONA TO MONTCLAIR

Due to unfavorable economic conditions affecting bid prices, the alignment contract was restructured to terminate in Pomona with a two-year option to extend to Montclair. The option expired in October 2021. Additional funding of approximately \$798 million is now needed to extend the project from Pomona to Montclair. Staff is working with Metro and other appropriate entities to secure the additional funds needed to complete the project to Montclair.

#### **COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

On March 19, 2020, the Governor issued Executive Order N-33-20, which mandates that all residents of the State shelter in place. That Order excepted individuals needed to maintain continuity of federal critical infrastructure sectors, as outlined at <a href="https://www.cisa.gov/identifying-critical-infrastructure-during-covid-19">https://www.cisa.gov/identifying-critical-infrastructure-during-covid-19</a>. Transportation, which includes the construction of light rail projects, is identified as an exempt critical infrastructure sector. As such, the project can continue to proceed during the ongoing pandemic. However, the pandemic has resulted in many project participants, including Construction Authority staff, to begin working from home, and has increased the risk of third parties not performing as agreed. Construction Authority staff has been proactively working with all third parties and project stakeholders to ensure the project continues during the pandemic. To date, all third parties and project stakeholders have performed as agreed and no significant disruption to the project has occurred. Staff will continue to do everything possible to keep the project on schedule. Any significant disruption to the project that may occur will be mitigated to the fullest extent possible.











#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Board of Directors approve a work authorization for Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 with Southern California Regional Rail Authority (SCRRA), in an amount not to exceed \$100,00 to support the Foothill Gold Line Phase 2B2 project.

#### **SUMMARY:**

During the planning, design and construction and testing of rail transit projects such as the Foothill Gold Line Phase 2B2 light rail project, significant support from project stakeholders is required. This support has been typically obtained via work authorizations and funded by the agency responsible for the project's design and construction.

The Construction Authority and SCRRA previously negotiated a Master Cooperative Agreement (MCA) in May 2018, for the full Phase 2B extension from Glendora to Montclair. SCRRA's participation during the design and construction of the Foothill Gold Line project are defined in the MCA. The MCA previously established an overall budget cap not-to-exceed \$4,929,370 for the life of the entire project. Inclusive of this current agenda item, \$2,003,585 of work authorizations have been issued. A revised MCA for Phase 2B2 is under review by both parties.

The action contained herein provides funding for SCRRA's continued participation with the Foothill Gold Line Phase 2B2 project into fiscal year 2025 as Construction Authority staff and SCRRA continue to negotiate a new MCA and budget for SCRRA's support, including project management, coordination meetings, design review, engineering support, construction support, training support, and other tasks as necessary.

#### **BUDGET IMPLICATIONS:**

Funds for this SCRRA work authorization in the amount of \$100,000 will be funded from WBS 2.15.99.01.N.9898 Phase 2B2 Master Cooperative Agreement SCRRA, which has an approved financial plan revision 18 budget of \$2,370.9 million and a MCA budget of \$60 million, and an approved FY25 Operating Budget of \$150 million which includes a Master Cooperative Agreement budget of \$1 million.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Construction Authority Board approve the recommended shortlist to receive Request for Proposals (RFP) C3001 for Phase 2B2 Pomona to Montclair Design-Build Project.

#### **SUMMARY:**

On March 13, 2024, the Construction Authority issued a Request for Statements of Qualifications (RFQ) for design-builder(s) interested in pursuing the design and construction of the Phase 2B2 Pomona to Montclair Design-Build Project. The purpose of the RFQ is to create a "shortlist" of qualified design-builder(s) who will be eligible to receive the subsequent Request for Proposals (RFP) C3001 Pomona to Montclair Design-Build Contract. On June 12, 2024 the Construction Authority received one Statement of Qualifications from Kiewit Infrastructure West Co. ("Kiewit") in response to the RFQ. Evaluators completed their review of the Statement of Qualifications and found Kiewit to be qualified.

#### **BUDGET IMPLICATIONS:**

None at this time.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The purpose of the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) is to create a "shortlist" of qualified design-builder(s) who will be eligible to receive the subsequent Request for Proposals (RFP) C3001 Pomona to Montclair Design-Build Contract and provide design-build services for the Phase 2B2 Pomona to Montclair Design-Build Project, which includes the relocation of existing rail, design and construction of a new light rail system, and other work between the terminus in Pomona and the City of Montclair. The RFQ was issued on March 13, 2024. Prior to its issuance, the RFQ

was posted on the Construction Authority's website; announced on the Construction Authority's

Business Opportunities Database (twice); announced in the Los Angeles Times, the San Gabriel Valley Tribune, the LA Daily News, Business Life Magazine, Engineering News Record (ENR – twice), California Constructor Magazine, and the Construction Dive eNewsletter; and was announced at various public and stakeholder outreach events such as at the CMAA's "owner's night" and at the ACEC California Annual Conference.

The RFQ solicits information regarding Related Project Experience, Staffing and Organization, Legal Qualifications, and Financial Qualifications. Consistent with the procurement schedule, on June 12, 2024 the Construction Authority received one Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) from Kiewit Infrastructure West Co. (Kiewit) in response to the RFQ.

Construction Authority staff and evaluators completed their review of Kiewit's SOQ per the process set out in the request for qualifications. After the evaluators reviewed the SOQ individually, they came together in their committees to deliberate as a group and collectively assign an adjectival rating to the SOQ for the criteria and sub-criteria for which they were responsible (shown in the table below). Each of the committees reached their determination unanimously. Adjectival ratings included "Exceptional", "Good", "Acceptable", and "Unacceptable". In assigning these ratings, evaluators also used "+" and "-" qualifiers in order to more clearly differentiate the ratings.

Once the evaluation committees completed their reviews, the chairperson of each committee compiled the committee's evaluations and forwarded them to the Chief Contracting Officer. These were gathered together and presented to the Chief Executive Officer, who reviewed the results and made a final recommendation to the Board as to the shortlist.

Below is a table showing the evaluation results for Kiewit's SOQ:

Kiewit's SOQ was found to be compliant and had ratings at or above "Acceptable" for all criteria. Therefore, Construction Authority staff recommends that Kiewit be approved as the only firm on the shortlist to receive Request for Proposals (RFP) C3001 for Phase 2B2 Pomona to Montclair Design-Build Project.
