GAREY AVE. RAILROAD CROSSING CONSTRUCTION NORTH OF ARROW HWY. (CITY OF POMONA)

ONGOING - May 31, 2026 (EXTENDED)

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

As part of the 9-mile Foothill Gold Line light rail project, crews will continue construction on Garey Ave. at the railroad crossing north of Arrow Hwy. and south of Bonita Ave. to complete final aesthetic and punchlist operations. Northbound and southbound lanes on Garey Ave. at the railroad crossing will be closed intermittently in each direction. One lane in each direction will be maintained at all times. Access to residential areas and businesses will be maintained at all times.

WHEN

Ongoing and continuing thru May 31, 2026.

- Intermittent lane closures will be in effect in both directions during daylight hours only.
- Allowable Work Hours: 7:00 AM - 5:00 PM, Monday thru Saturday.

WHERE

Construction activities will take place in both northbound and southbound lanes of Garey Ave. between Arrow Hwy. and Bonita Ave., at the railroad crossing. Thru traffic and access to residential areas and businesses will be maintained at all times.

TRAFFIC ADVISORIES

- One lane in each direction on Garey Ave. between Arrow Hwy. and Bonita Ave. at the railroad crossing will be closed intermittently. One lane in each direction will be maintained at all times.
- Access to residential areas and businesses will be maintained at all times.

NOTE TO RESIDENTS / BUSINESS OWNERS

The red area in the map shows the work zone. Access thru the work zone will be available throughout the duration of these operations.

Please obey all posted construction signs and do not enter the construction work zone.
