Vegetation Removal within Railroad Corridor in Arcadia, CA

Attention residents, businesses, and organizations in the vicinity of the existing railroad corridor from Huntington Dr to 5th Ave in Arcadia, CA.

WHAT

Crews will be removing previously identified trees and shrubs, as well as debris and inactive signal poles, from the railroad corridor in preparation for the construction of the 11.5-mile Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension light rail project.

WHEN

This work is scheduled to begin on Wednesday, December 5, 2012 and will continue intermittently until December 31, 2012, weather permitting. Anticipated work hours are Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

WHERE

Crews will be working within the railroad corridor between Huntington Dr and 5th Ave in Arcadia, CA.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- All work will be performed within the railroad corridor.
- Construction equipment noise will be heard near active work zones.
- Watering equipment will be used to control dust.
