Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension
- Pasadena to Azusa -

Railroad Bridge Construction at Santa Anita Wash in Monrovia, CA

WHAT

Crews will be working to remove and replace the existing railroad bridge over Santa Anita Wash as part of the 11.5-mile Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension light rail project. Construction activities will include demolition, excavation, foundation construction and installation of the new bridge structure at this location for a period of approximately 4 months.

WHEN

Work is scheduled to begin on Monday, February 25, 2013 and will continue through June 2013, weather permitting. Work hours are Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Note: Possible weekend work may be needed to complete this work as scheduled.

WHERE

Crews will be working at the railroad bridge over the Santa Anita Wash in Monrovia, CA.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- The Santa Anita Wash Trail will be closed during this work.
- Equestrian access to the trail will be closed Monday through Friday and will remain open on Saturdays and Sundays only. Pedestrians and bicyclists will be detoured to the 5th Avenue pedestrian tunnel.
- Construction equipment noise should be expected.
- Watering equipment will be used to control dust.
