Utility Installation on Flower St in Arcadia

WHAT

Work crews will be installing underground utilities on the south side of Flower Street, as part of the 11.5-mile Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension light rail project. The parking on the south side of Flower Street will be restricted during this work.

WHEN

Work is scheduled to begin Tuesday, July 30 through mid-August 2013. Construction work hours are 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday. Note: Occasional longer work hours, work on Sundays and/or night work may be performed to complete this activity.

WHERE

Crews will be working on Flower St and St Joseph St, just north of the railroad corridor and east of 1st Avenue in the City of Arcadia..

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Parking on the south side of Flower St will be restricted and temporary “No Parking” signs will be posted
- Noise from construction equipment will be produced near the active work zones.
- Watering equipment will be used to control dust
