HYDRANT RELOCATION ON CORNELL DR. IN ARCADIA

WHAT

Work crews will be relocating the hydrant on Cornell Dr., as part of the 11.5-mile Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension light rail project. This work will consist of crews excavating the road, rerouting the line to the new hydrant and restoring the road once the hydrant relocation is complete.

WHEN

Work is scheduled to begin Monday, October 14, 2013 and will continue for approximately 1 week. Construction work hours are 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

WHERE

Crews will be working on Cornell Dr., just north of the railroad corridor in the City of Arcadia.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Cornell Dr. will be narrowed to one lane for both eastbound and westbound traffic during the work activity and flaggers will be present to direct traffic.
- Parking near the work area will be temporarily restricted.
- Noise from construction equipment will be produced near the active work zones.
- Watering equipment will be used to control dust.
