Full Closure of Colorado Boulevard for Bridge Removal

Attention residents, businesses, and organizations in the vicinity of Colorado Boulevard and Santa Anita Avenue in Arcadia, CA.

REMINDER

Work continues on the removal of the Colorado Boulevard rail bridge, located between San Antonio Road and Santa Anita Avenue in Arcadia.

As a reminder, Colorado Boulevard will be closed to thru traffic beginning Monday, June 11, 2012 at 7:00 a.m. and will remain closed until Friday, June 15, 2012 at 5:00 p.m. The closure during this period is a full, 24-hour closure, and vehicles and pedestrians will be detoured.

Importantly, all work will be performed during the daytime work hours of 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. only.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Local access to residences and businesses will be maintained by use of access streets along the detour route.
- During closures, thru-traffic for vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians will be detoured to Colorado Place and Santa Clara Street (see detour map on reverse side).
- Construction equipment noise will be heard near active work zones.

Construction schedules are subject to change for various reasons, including, but not limited to, weather conditions and unforeseen delays.

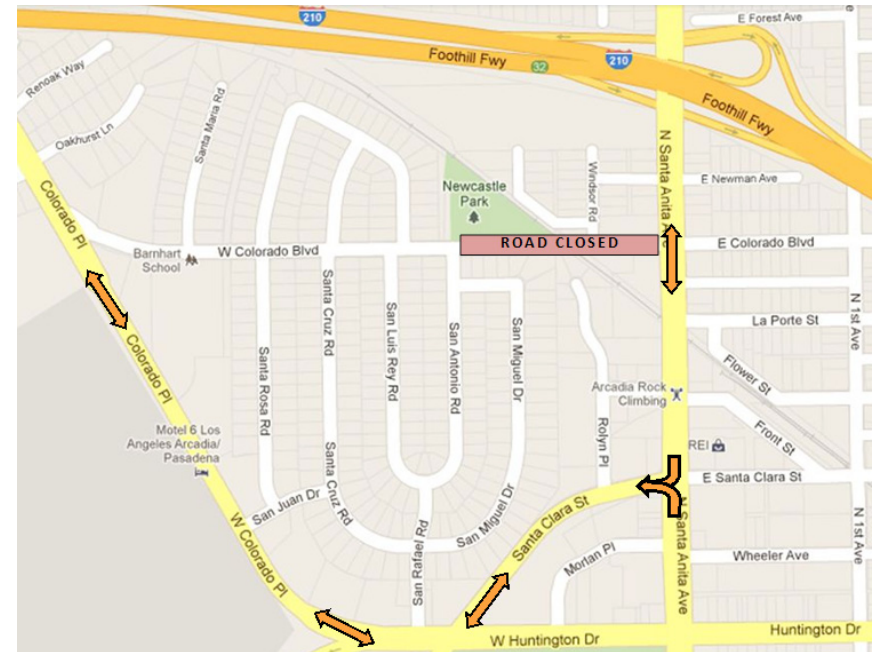
