



GOLD LINE BRIDGE BI-WEEKLY CONSTRUCTION NOTICE OCTOBER 28 - NOVEMBER 10, 2012



WHAT: Construction activity may require occasional lane closures of the eastbound I-210 Freeway.

WHEN: Occasional lane closures of up to three eastbound lanes of the I-210 Freeway may take place during this bi-weekly period. These lane closures will start no earlier than 10 p.m. and end by 1 p.m. the following day. No full closures of the eastbound I-210 Freeway are scheduled for this bi-weekly period.

WHERE: Eastbound lanes of the I-210 Freeway, between Baldwin Ave. and Santa Anita Ave.

WHAT TO EXPECT: During the next two weeks, crews will continue installing the Gold Line Bridge's signature basket features (the southern "basket" is nearly complete) and retaining walls leading up to the bridge's two abutments. When complete, the area between the two retaining walls at each abutment will be backfilled with soil to the level of the bridge deck.

NOTE: Construction schedules are subject to change for various reasons including but not limited to weather conditions and unforeseen delays. Please note that other construction projects are also affecting the Arcadia stretch of the I-210 Freeway.
