



# GOLD LINE BRIDGE BI-WEEKLY CONSTRUCTION NOTICE NOVEMBER 11 - 24, 2012



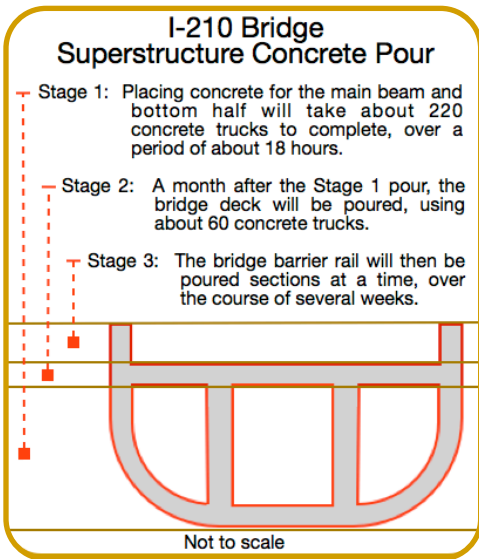
**WHAT:** Construction activity will require occasional lane closures of the eastbound I-210 Freeway.

**WHEN:** One full closure of the eastbound I-210 Freeway is anticipated for this bi-weekly period. Additional lane closures of up to three eastbound lanes of the I-210 Freeway may also take place during this bi-weekly period. These lane closures will start no earlier than 10 p.m. and end by 1 p.m. the following day.

**WHERE:** Eastbound lanes of the I-210 Freeway, between Baldwin Ave. and Santa Anita Ave.

**WHAT TO EXPECT:** During the next two weeks, crews will continue installing the retaining walls leading up to the bridge's two abutments and will begin to pour concrete for the bridge barrier rail (see below graphic on stage 3 of the superstructure concrete pour). Crews will also remove construction materials, such as the steel and wood used for the falsework, from the I-210 Freeway's center median.

*NOTE: Construction schedules are subject to change for various reasons including but not limited to weather conditions and unforeseen delays. Please note that other construction projects are also affecting the Arcadia stretch of the I-210 Freeway.
