



GOLD LINE BRIDGE BI-WEEKLY CONSTRUCTION NOTICE DECEMBER 9 - 15, 2012



FINAL NOTICE - BRIDGE WORK TO BE COMPLETED DURING THIS PERIOD

WHAT: Construction activity will require up to four full closures of the eastbound I-210 Freeway.

WHEN: Four full closures of the eastbound I-210 Freeway are anticipated during this final week of construction. These closures will start no earlier than 11 p.m. and end by 5 a.m. the following morning.

WHERE: Eastbound lanes and associated on-ramps of the I-210 Freeway, between Baldwin Ave. and Santa Anita Ave.

WHAT TO EXPECT: The Gold Line Bridge Project will be completed by Skanska crews this week, at which point it will be handed over to the Foothill Extension project alignment contractor, Foothill Transit Constructors. During this last week of construction, Skanska crews will perform finishing work on the bridge structure and remove equipment including the temporary k-rail lining each side of the eastbound I-210 Freeway.

NOTE: Construction schedules are subject to change for various reasons including but not limited to weather conditions and unforeseen delays. Please note that other construction projects are also affecting the Arcadia stretch of the I-210 Freeway.
