Re: Retaining Wall Construction within Railroad Corridor between I-210 Gold Line Bridge and Colorado Boulevard.

Dear Neighbor,

Construction within the railroad corridor between the I-210 Gold Line Bridge and Colorado Blvd continues. During the past few months, crews have performed the soil grading and relocated various underground utilities in this area. This week crews began the excavation needed to start building the new retaining walls. The excavation and installation of the new retaining walls will take place during the next few months and the temporary fences currently installed will be removed when they are no longer needed.

Following the completion of these walls, construction activities will continue within the railroad corridor with the installation of soundwalls, light rail tracks and overhead electrical cables that will power the Metro Gold Line light rail trains.
