One-day Closure of Duarte Road at Hope Drive

WHAT

Crews will install new traffic signals on Duarte Road at Hope Drive in the City of Duarte (this is the main entrance to the City of Hope). During this work, Duarte Road will be closed to thru-traffic at Hope Drive for one day to install underground conduit in preparation for the traffic signal installation. Once completed, this will become a three-way signalized intersection. This work is being performed as part of the 11.5-mile Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension light rail project.

WHEN

Work is scheduled to take place on Saturday, July 26, 2014 from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

WHERE

Crews will be working on Duarte Road at Hope Drive located between Buena Vista Street and Highland Avenue in the City of Duarte (this is the main entrance to the City of Hope).

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Thru-traffic on Duarte Road in both eastbound and westbound directions will be closed at Hope Drive.
- Access to City of Hope will be available from Buena Vista Street, Village Road, and Circle Road.
- Following the one-day closure, work will continue in the area with at least one lane of thru-traffic open in each direction.
