- Pasadena to Azusa -

Palm Drive Closure to Install Decorative Concrete Panels on North Side of the Bridge

- Daily Road Closure -

WHAT

Crews will install the decorative concrete panels on the North side of the light rail bridge over Palm Drive, as part of the 11.5-mile Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension light rail project. To accomplish this work, a daily full closure of Palm Drive at the railroad bridges will be required for approximately four days.

WHEN

Palm Drive will be closed to thru-traffic at the railroad bridges from Tuesday, October 7, 2014 to Friday, October 10, 2014. The road will be closed from 7:00 a.m. to no later than 6:00 p.m. during the closure dates.

WHERE

Crews will be working on Palm Drive at the railroad bridges in Azusa, CA.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Palm Drive will be closed to thru-traffic during the day at the railroad bridges, located between 9th Street and Sycamore Drive, for the duration of this work. Detour signs will be posted to direct vehicular traffic to Pasadena Avenue via 9th Street or Foothill Blvd.

No pedestrian access will be allowed.

Construction equipment noise will be heard near active work zones from 7:00am to 6:00pm.
