Palm Drive Closure to Perform Final Paving Work - One Day Road Closure -

WHAT

Construction crews will grind the existing pavement and overlay with new asphalt where the roadway has been excessively worn or damaged due to the construction of the new Gold Line bridges. A one day full closure of Palm Drive at the railroad bridges is required to accomplish this work, as part of the 11.5-mile Foothill Gold Line project. Special note for the Sierra Palms HOA: access to Sycamore Drive from Palm Drive will be closed.

WHEN

- Palm Drive will be closed to thru-traffic at the railroad bridges from Wednesday, November 19, 2014 from 8:00 a.m. to no later than 6:00 p.m.

WHERE

- Crews will be working on Palm Drive at the railroad bridges in Azusa, CA. The closure will be on Palm Drive from 9th Street to Silver Maple Drive.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Palm Drive will be closed to thru-traffic in both directions for one day at the railroad bridges, located between 9th Street and Silver Maple Drive.
- Detour signs will be posted to direct vehicular traffic to Pasadena Avenue via 9th Street or Foothill Blvd.
- Pedestrian access via the sidewalks will be **open**.
- Construction equipment noise will be heard near active work zones from 7:00am to 6:00pm.
