Foothill Gold Line - Pasadena to Azusa -



Train Testing - Extended Work Hours

WHAT

Train testing has begun in the city of Duarte and portions of Irwindale. Thoughout the next several months this testing will expand to all areas of the corridor (including Arcadia, Monrovia and Azusa). In order to maintain the testing schedule, some construction activities will need to be done during a second shift (3:30 pm to 11:00 pm). Operations near residentail areas that generate excesive noise will conclude at 9:00 pm. This extra shift allows construction to be completed when trains are not operating on the tracks. This work is part of the 11.5-mile Foothill Gold Line light rail project.

WHEN

Train testing starts in earnest in February 2015 and will continue through the Summer 2015. During testing, crews will need to periodically work extended hours (3:30 pm to 11:00 pm) at different points along the rail corridor. Operations near residentail areas that generate excesive noise will conclude at 9:00 pm.

WHERE

Train testing will occur throughout the 11.5-mile project corridor. Periodically, extended work hours will be needed throughout the corridor. Operations near residentail areas that generate excesive noise will conclude at 9:00 pm.

WHAT TO EXPECT

When needed, a second shift will begin as the testing shift ends. The work performed in this second shift will be using on-track equipment and lighting. Operations near residentail areas that generate excesive noise will conclude at 9:00 pm.

SAFETY TIPS:

- * Never walk on the train tracks
- * Never go around lowered gates
- * Obey all warning signs
- * Watch for trains from both directions
