Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Pasadena to Azusa

Underground Utility Work at Duarte Road and Highland Avenue, Duarte, CA

Attention residents, businesses, and organizations in the vicinity of Duarte Road and Highland Avenue, Duarte, CA

WHAT

Crews will be performing trenching necessary to reinforce the existing sewer line for the construction of the 11.5-mile Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension light rail project. Some lane closures are required to accomplish this work.

WHEN

This activity is scheduled to begin on Monday, May 14 and will continue until Thursday, May 23, weather permitting. Anticipated work hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

WHERE

Crews will be working on the Foothill Extension right-of-way along Duarte Road near Hope Drive and on Highland Avenue where it meets with Duarte Road in the City of Duarte, CA.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Right lane along westbound Duarte Road near Hope Drive and center lanes where Highland Avenue and Duarte Road meet will be intermittently closed. The closures will be implemented separately.
- Some slowdown in traffic may occur.
- Thru-traffic will be maintained for vehicles and cyclists at all times. Pedestrians may be detoured.
- Access will be maintained for local residences and businesses.
- Signs will be posted to indicate street parking restrictions.
- Construction equipment noise will be heard near active work zones.
