Construction Notice

Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension
Pasadena to Azusa

Underground Utility Examination on Duarte Road in Monrovia, CA

Attention residents, businesses, and organizations in the vicinity of Duarte Road near the existing railroad tracks in Monrovia, CA.

WHAT

Construction crews will be investigating existing underground utilities as part of pre-construction activities for the 11.5-mile Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension light rail project. The location of existing underground utilities must be verified using an electronic device and vacuum excavation equipment. Closure of a shoulder lane is required to accomplish this work.

WHEN

This operation is scheduled to take place Friday, July 20, 2012, weather permitting. Anticipated work hours will be from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

WHERE

Crews will be working at two locations on the right shoulder of westbound Duarte Road, between Shamrock Avenue and Mountain Avenue in Monrovia, CA.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- The right shoulder of westbound Duarte Road will be temporarily closed at the work areas.
- Thru-traffic will be maintained for vehicles at all times.
- At times, heavy equipment noises will occur.
