## Installation of Underground Utilities in Glendora, CA

Attention residents, businesses, and organizations in the vicinity of the existing railroad tracks in Glendora, CA.

## WHAT

Crews will begin installation of underground electrical conduit and utility boxes as part of the construction of the 11.5 -mile Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension light rail project. This work requires trench excavation within the railroad corridor between N. Citrus Avenue and N. Barranca Avenue in Glendora, CA.

## WHEN

This operation is scheduled to begin Wednesday, August 1, 2012, and will continue intermittently until Thursday, November 1, 2012, weather permitting. Anticipated work hours are from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

## WHERE

Crews will be working within the railroad corridor located north of W. Foothill Boulevard, between N. Citrus Avenue and N. Barranca Avenue within the city of Glendora.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

- All of the work will be within the railroad corridor; street lane closures are not required for this work.
- Access for local residences and businesses will not be affected.
- Construction equipment noise will be heard near active work zones.
- Flaggers will be used to direct traffic when equipment enters and exits the railroad right-of-way.
- Watering equipment will be used to control dust.
