Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Construction Authority What is an SBE?

An SBE is a Small Business Enterprise that meets specific race-neutral ownership and economic criteria established by State and Federal guidelines. SBE eligibility requirements vary among contracting agencies depending on the funding source used on their projects. Projects that are federally funded require SBE certification standards as defined by the United States Small Business Administration (SBA) and those that are State funded require SBE certification standards as defined by the California Department of General Services (DGS). The two accepted definitions are below:

State Small Business Definition: California Department of General Services

- Be independently owned and operated;
- Not dominant in field of operation;
- Principal office located in California;
- Owners (officers, if a corporation) domiciled in California; and,
- Including affiliates, be either,
- A business with 100 or fewer employees; an average annual gross receipts of \$14 million or less, over the last three tax years;
- A manufacturer* with 100 or fewer employees; or,
- A microbusiness. A small business will automatically be designated as a microbusiness, if gross annual receipts are less than \$3,500,000; or the small business is a manufacturer with 25 or fewer employees.

Federal Small Business Definition: Small Business Administration

- Is organized for profit;
- Has a place of business in the US;
- Operates primarily within the U.S. or makes a significant contribution to the U.S. economy through payment of taxes or use of American products, materials or labor;
- Is independently owned and operated;
- Is not dominant in its field on a national basis; and
- Meets <u>size standards</u>, which vary by NAICS (i.e. General building and heavy construction contractors: \$33.5 million; Special trade construction contractors: \$14 million)

Small businesses who meet the above standards can be certified as an SBE. There are various agencies that provide SBE certification. The Authority recognizes SBE certifications from:

- MTA
- DGS
- City of Los Angeles
- Caltrans
- Other certifying agencies may be evaluated on a case-by-case basis
