

Construction on the I-210 Gold Line Bridge is set to begin in the coming weeks. The bridge is the first element of the Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension light rail project to move from final design to construction. The I-210 Bridge is scheduled to be completed in July 2012. The entire Foothill Extension from Pasadena to Azusa is scheduled to be completed by early 2015.

The Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Construction Authority will be issuing construction notices every other week to update the community on upcoming construction activities for the bridge. <u>To continue to receive these notices directly, you must register.</u> Return the attached (postage-paid) postcard today, or sign up on the Authority's website:

- WHAT: Start of Construction of I-210 Gold Line Bridge Register with the Construction Authority to receive construction notices
- WHEN: Construction will take approximately 1 year (June 27, 2011 through July 2012)
- WHERE: The eastbound lanes of the I-210 Freeway, between Baldwin and Santa Anita Avenues

WHAT TO EXPECT: On June 27, 2011, work will begin to prepare the site for construction of the I-210 Bridge, including the construction of a temporary retaining wall in the freeway's center median. In July, work will begin on the bridge's foundations. Intermittent partial and/or full freeway closures of the eastbound I-210 lanes will occur over the year of construction, mostly from midnight to 5:00 a.m. Traffic will be detoured along Foothill Boulevard (see map on back side).

I-210 GOLD LINE BRIDGE UPDATE

Construction is starting on the Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension light rail bridge over the eastbound lanes of the I-210 Freeway. Design and pre-construction on the I-210 Bridge is nearly complete – and soon crews and equipment will begin work along the freeway.

Over the next few months, the I-210 Bridge contractor (Skanska) will begin construction on the foundations for the bridge. Initial work will consist of constructing several deep concrete foundations ranging in size from 3 to 11 feet in diameter and up to 110 feet deep. Once the foundations are complete, construction of the bridge structure itself will begin in the Fall which will require installation of temporary falsework (or support) across the eastbound freeway lanes. Intermittent late-night closures of the eastbound freeway lanes will be required during this phase of the project. The map below shows the planned detour route:
