# Construction Notice



Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension  
Pasadena to Azusa

## Underground Utility Investigation at Railroad Street Crossing

Attention residents, businesses, and organizations in the vicinity of the existing railroad tracks near I-210 in Monrovia, CA.

Construction crews will be investigating soil conditions as part of pre-construction activities for the 11.5-mile Metro Gold Line light rail extension project.

### WHAT

Soil samples will be taken using a small truck-mounted drill rig. Lane closures are not required to accomplish this work.

### WHEN

This operation is scheduled to begin Thursday, March 22 and will be completed by Thursday, April 5, weather permitting. Anticipated work hours will be from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm.

### WHERE

Crews will be working in one of two locations by the railroad tracks in the city of Monrovia:

- Monterrey Avenue cul-de-sac
- 5th Avenue cul-de-sac

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- Access will be maintained for local residences and businesses.
- Construction crews will be in the street.
- At times, heavy equipment noises will occur.
- Lane closures are not required to accomplish this work.
