Pasadena to Azusa

Vegetation Removal within Railroad Corridor in Arcadia, CA

Attention residents, businesses, and organizations in the vicinity of the existing railroad corridor between Colorado Blvd. and Huntington Dr. in Arcadia, CA.

WHAT

Crews will be removing previously identified trees and shrubs, as well as debris, from the railroad corridor in preparation for the construction of the 11.5-mile Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension light rail project.

WHEN

This work is scheduled to take place from Monday, November 5, 2012 through Friday, November 16, 2012, weather permitting. Anticipated work hours are Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

WHERE

Crews will be working within the railroad corridor in two separate locations; between Colorado Blvd and Santa Anita Ave and between Santa Clara St and Huntington Dr. in Arcadia, CA. All work is confined within the railroad corridor.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- All work will be performed within the railroad corridor.
- Construction equipment noise will be heard near active work zones.
- Watering equipment will be used to control dust.
