The Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Construction Authority (Construction Authority) and cities from Glendora to Montclair invite you participate in a series of workshops on the proposed Gold Line stations in Glendora, San Dimas, La Verne, Pomona, Claremont and Montclair. These stations are included as part of the proposed 12.6-mile extension of the Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension from Azusa to Montclair currently under environmental review. The workshops are an opportunity to learn the latest station plans and provide feedback on ways to make the plans even better.


